Main Description

The works consisted of the provision of a new access road, including footpaths and associated infrastructure to service Green King Development amenity restaurant at Nova Business Park, Robroyston. The access road and footpaths were built to a standard necessary for adoption by the Roads Authority. The works included – construction of an estate road, installation of street lighting, utility provision including drainage, site servicing, and SUDS.

Works Included:

- Clearing of vegetation and topsoil and excavate to the correct levels.
- Co-ordinate the installation of the electrical, gas, water and telecoms services & protection of all existing services.
- Connection to existing foul and surface water systems.
- Installation of Sustainable Urban Drainage Scheme (SUDS) on site & associated headwalls.
- Removal of all contaminated and surplus spoil from site to agreed waste disposal site/facility.
- Construction of access road to the specification of the Roads Authority.
- Construction of footpaths with drop kerbs and tactile slab crossings
- Adapting and altering adjacent roadways & hard standings to tie into new road.
- Road lining and signage throughout the site.
- Installation of street lighting along the length of the road.
- SUDS planting and general landscaping along the access road.
